



TEN MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. What is the Together Rx Access™ Card?

A. The Together Rx Access Card was created by 10 pharmaceutical companies to help hardworking Americans and their families gain access to meaningful savings on prescriptions right at the pharmacy counter. Most cardholders save 25 percent to 40 percent* on brand-name prescription products, including medicines to treat high cholesterol, diabetes, asthma, and many other conditions. Over 300 brand-name prescription products are included in the program. Savings are also available on a range of generic products. The Card is accepted at the majority of pharmacies nationwide and in Puerto Rico.

Q. Who is eligible?

A. To qualify for the Together Rx Access Card, applicants must:

- Not be eligible for Medicare
- Have no prescription drug coverage (public or private)
- Have household income equal to or less than
 - \$30,000 for a single person
 - \$40,000 for a family of two
 - \$50,000 for a family of three
 - \$60,000 for a family of four
 - \$70,000 for a family of five
- Be a legal resident of the US or Puerto Rico

Families of six or more and residents of Alaska and Hawaii should contact Together Rx Access at 1-800-444-4106 for household income information.

Q. How do I know if I'm eligible?

A. To find out if you're eligible and to enroll, please call 1-800-444-4106 or visit TogetherRxAccess.com. In addition, the Together Rx Access Program directs individuals to the Partnership for Prescription Assistance (PPA), a clearinghouse for over 475 public and private assistance programs, including participating companies' existing Patient Assistance Programs.

Q. What does the Together Rx Access Card cost?

A. Enrolling is absolutely free. There is no cost to use the Card. And, you get your savings right at the pharmacy counter.

- Q. Where can I use the Together Rx Access Card?**
- A. This easy-to-use Card is accepted at the majority of pharmacies nationwide and in Puerto Rico. Simply bring it to your pharmacist along with your prescription, and your savings will be calculated right at the pharmacy counter. It's that easy.
